IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL NOTICE

Dear Suzuki Owner:

This notice is being sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Suzuki Motor Corporation has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain 2011 and 2012 Suzuki Equator vehicles. According to our records, you own one of the vehicles affected by this recall. The recall designator code is NT.

On some affected vehicles, the bolt that connects the engine oil cooler and the engine oil filter to the engine may have been manufactured to below specification strength. On vehicles equipped with the affected bolt, the bolt may break at the oil filter attachment point and it can cause an oil leak. If there is an engine oil leak, the engine oil warning lamp will illuminate and the engine may produce abnormal sounds. If the driver ignores this condition and the vehicle continues to be driven, the engine could seize, increasing the risk of a crash.

To correct this condition, your Suzuki dealer will replace the engine oil cooler connecter bolt on your vehicle with an improved part. The connector bolt seal and oil filter will also be replaced and the engine oil will be adjusted to the correct level. This service will be performed at no cost to you for parts, fluids and labor.

If you no longer own this vehicle, please complete the enclosed postage-paid reply card and return it to us.
